TINIAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT EMERGENCY CONTINGENCY PLAN

Tinian International Airport has prepared this Emergency Plan pursuant to ss42301 of the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012. Questions regarding this plan can be directed to the Tinian Ports Manager at cpatinian1@pticom.com. Tinian International Airport is filing this plan with the Department of Transportation because (1) it is a commercial airport and it may be used by an air carrier for diversions, as described in USC 42301(a)(1).

This plan describes how, following excessive tarmac delays and to the extent practical, Tinian International Airport will:

- Provide for the deplanement of passengers
- Provide for the sharing of facilities
- Provide a sterile area following excessive tarmac delays for passengers who have not yet cleared United States Customs & Border Protection (CBP).

Terminal Limitation: Tinian International Airport has facility constraints that limit our ability to accommodate diverted flights or maintain the airport's safe operation and strongly encourages aircraft operators to contact the airport at phone # (670) 433-9294/6 and fax # (670) 433-0790 for prior coordination of diverted flights, except in the case of a declared emergency.

Specific facility constraints include the following:

- Terminal facility configuration limits the ability of the airport to provide for a large sterile area
- There is no loading bridge

During diversion events, Tinian International Airport will issue NOTAMs regarding its ability to accommodate diverted flights to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the airport and its ability to serve the civil aviation needs of the public during irregular operation events.
